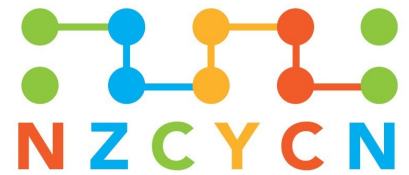


22/23 Q3 NETWORK REPORT HIGHLIGHTS

DATA & INFORMATION:



The Allergy CRG's **Epipen in Schools Survey** reviewed the use of adrenaline-autoinjectors and management of anaphylaxis in NZ schools, data from **983** schools has been collected and evaluated.

Child Disability & Development CRG survey on **health professional needs for managing Down Syndrome** results analysed and published in infographic.



PROFESSIONAL TRAINING & EVENTS:

The Neurology CRG supported **386** Professionals to complete the **Paediatric Epilepsy Training** (PET) in 2023. Further sessions scheduled.

Child Development & Disability CRG **Lunch and Learn** Zoom educational sessions restarted in March 2023 with **“What caregivers say about sleep systems and what we can do about it.”**
